Be courteous to fellow members, guests. Unless otherwise directed, NO PLAYING, NO TALKING, while others are performing.

Your undivided attention toward the speaker is a necessity so the greatest benefit can be derived by each member.

In keeping with the purpose of SPAH, those who are advanced or semi-professional players should bear in mind their responsibility in assisting beginners or intermediate players.

Except when performing for demonstration purposes, formed GROUPS should not congregate by themselves and use the club meeting for a practice session.

New members, guests and all members in all stages of development must be made welcome and aware of SPAH's sincerity in the goals we have established.

Recording artists as well as recording engineers depend on the sale of their products as a source of income. Let us refrain from retaping records and tape recordings as long as they are commercially available.

The practice by many to "Zerox" published music still within copyright is against the law. The practice is illegal and SPAH's official position is with the law.
